RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY PERSISTS, RE-RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY BY GOVERNOR NEWSOM'S ORDER DATED MARCH 4, 2020, AND RE-AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODIES OF THE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 10, 2023, TO FEBRUARY 8, 2023, PURSUANT TO BROWN ACT PROVISIONS

Recitals

WHEREAS, the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority ("IWMA") is committed to preserving and nurturing public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the IWMA's legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code, \S 54950 – 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the IWMA's legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provision for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within the IWMA's boundaries, caused by natural, technological or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is further required that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors previously adopted RESOLUTION NO. 2021-10-01, on September 30, 2021, finding that the requisite conditions exist for the legislative bodies of the IWMA to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of extending the use of the provisions found in section 54953(e), the Board of Directors must reconsider the circumstances of the state of emergency that exists in the IWMA jurisdiction, and the Board of Directors has done so; and

WHEREAS, emergency conditions persist in the jurisdiction of the IWMA, specifically, the State of Emergency declared by Governor Newsom on March 4, 2020, due to COVID-19, and strong recommendations by the California Department of Public Health that all persons, regardless of vaccination status, continue to undertake social distancing measures including wearing masks while in indoor public settings; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the rise in SARS-CoV-2 Delta Variant has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the IWMA that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the IWMA, and desires to affirm a local emergency exists and re-ratify the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency persisting, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the legislative bodies of the IWMA shall continue to conduct their meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall continue to comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors will ensure that the public has access to meetings and the opportunity to participate in meetings in the interest of transparency and as required by AB 361.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority, as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.
- 2. Affirmation that Local Emergency Persists. The Board of Directors hereby considers the conditions of the state of emergency in the jurisdiction of the IWMA and proclaims that a local emergency persists throughout the jurisdiction of the IWMA, and COVID-19 has caused and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the jurisdiction of the IWMA that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the IWMA.

- 3. Re-ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency. The Board of Directors hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of March 4, 2020.
- 4. Remote Teleconference Meetings. The Executive Director and Staff of the IWMA are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, continuing to conduct open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.
- 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until the earlier of (i) February 8, 2023, or such time the Board of Directors adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend the time during which the legislative bodies of the IWMA may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.
