

TREATED WOOD WASTE

Treated Wood Waste (TWW) is now accepted at Paso Robles Landfill under a DTSC issued TWW Variance Permit under the following conditions:

1. TWW loads shall be segregated and not mixed with other waste as required by DTSC Health and Safety Code regulations;
2. TWW will only be accepted on Tuesdays and Thursdays by 10 am,
3. Each TWW customer load must provide gate attendant with TWW Generator name, address, phone number, DTSC Variance No. (if customer has one) and TWW Transporter's vehicle information, name, address, phone number, DTSC Variance No. (if customer has one);
4. TWW tipping fees shall be a minimum of \$61 per load for less than 1 ton, or uncompacted rate of \$61/ton until the City adopts higher rates specifically for TWW;
5. An extra charge for each "railroad tie" or "telephone pole" only will be accessed at \$5 each under current City approved rates until the City adopts higher rates specifically for TWW,
6. If the TWW is mixed in the customers load, the non-TWW must be unloaded at the active landfill face, customer must return to the gate house for weighing, customer recorded information, fee collection, and unloading at the designated TWW unloading area,
